A World of Opportunities: The Middle Years Programme (MYP)

The Middle Years Programme (MYP) is a five-year programme designed for learners aged 11–16 by the International Baccalaureate (IB). The MYP curriculum contains eight subject groups, providing a broad and balanced education. Students who complete the MYP are well prepared to undertake the IB Diploma Programme (DP) or equivalent.



The MYP is designed to address students' intellectual, social, emotional, and physical health. It ensures that students are provided with the opportunities to develop the knowledge, attitudes, and skills they will need in their future endeavors.



The teaching in MYP is more student-centered to empower students to evaluate their own learning needs so that they can emerge as independent learners. MYP encourages the study of at least two languages to enable students to understand their own cultures and those of others. It requires students to participate in services with the community to bring change in society and the world around them.



Empowering Global Citizens: The Diploma Programme (DP)

The IB Diploma Programme (DP) is a rigorous and well-balanced two-year educational programme for students aged 16 to 19. It prepares them for success in university and beyond by fostering their intellectual, social, emotional, and physical well-being. The programme is highly respected by leading universities worldwide.



The Diploma Programme Core

The DP goes beyond subject knowledge, fostering well-rounded students. In addition to their chosen subjects, all DP students participate in:

Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS):

This component encourages a holistic development by engaging students in creative pursuits, physical activities, and community service.

Theory of Knowledge (TOK):

This critical thinking course helps students explore the nature of knowledge and develop a strong learning foundation.

Extended Essay (EE):

Students conduct independent research and write an in-depth paper, honing research and writing skills.
